Along with the meeting itself, any interested Westside Wizards will have the opportunity to perform in two short magic shows that we'll be holding for visitors at the patch.

Some important details:

- 1. There's **no meeting at OPICA** this month. Meet at Shawn's instead: 11650 Santa Monica Blvd, in West Los Angeles.
- 2. Our meeting will start an hour earlier than usual, since the pumpkin patch closes at 8.
- 3. We'll be holding 15-minute **magic shows at 6:30 and 7:30 pm**. All skill levels welcome, but these shows are for the public so please arrive rehearsed and prepared.
- 4. We expect an all-ages, family audience, and we'll be performing outdoors in a loud, carnival-type atmosphere, so think visible, G-rated Parlor or Stage magic when planning the tricks that you'd like to share. In this setting, giant cards work better than standard.
- 5. Even if you're not performing, please come by to represent the Westside Wizards. Your eye for magic will help cue audience applause and iron out glitches.

As you know, the public loves seeing magic around Halloween, so surprising them with magic shows while they're out pumpkin hunting should be a lot of fun.

Separately, if you're looking for additional performing opportunities consider the Heyler Realty Harvest Fest on Oct. 22, in West Los Angeles. More on that elsewhere in this newsletter.

Before I wrap up, I'll quickly look ahead to November, when our guest lecturer will be (drumroll)... Mike Pisciotta!
