














President's Message

A word from Dan Cray...

Hello Westside Wizards,

As I write this, Los Angeles is in the midst of a second-straight day of nonstop rain and I find myself thinking, "what a nice excuse to stay inside and rehearse some magic."



Admittedly, that's not something most people think about when it rains, but having never lived in Seattle or any other wet locale, I'm that rare person who actually likes rain. I particularly enjoy the way it brings a fresh start by cleaning the dust from our city and the smog from our air. And, with the rain arriving not long after the start of a new year, it ties in nicely with the season when I like to experiment with new effects.

So, for me... rain equals magic.

I experienced a bit of both recently, when family events prompted a visit to rainy London. (Many thanks to VP Phil Goodman for stepping in to host our January meeting.) Though the late, legendary Davenport's magic shop closed in 2020, I instead found International Magic, which has "only" been open for 60-plus years. I also had a chance to see Gandalf's staff from the Peter Jackson films (it's covered in runes!), which was part of a fantasy display at the British Library.

Several years had passed since my last overseas trip so I'd forgotten how deeply magic, as a concept, is embedded in English culture. Small magic cabarets (not to mention our friends at the Magic Circle) are easy to find, as are exhibits with magic-themed paintings and engravings.

Historical sites tied to England's magical lore are everywhere as well—especially since John Dee, who supposedly possessed a "magic mirror of obsidian," served as an astrologer for Queen Elizabeth I. Then there's Treadwell's bookshop, which offers spiritualism and tarot readings for "modern esoteric society." To my surprise, the shop was less about rituals and more about the history of worldwide magical beliefs and practices.

Maybe that summarizes magic in England. One gets the sense that while people there enjoy a good show, they also feel a deeper connection, rooted in a history that's replete with druidic ceremonies, generations of superstitious charms, and the fact Stonehenge is a train ride away. It's different from magic in the U.S., which is generally considered pop culture entertainment rooted in children's birthday parties.

Our guest lecturer this month, mentalist Mark Gibson, is changing that by combining thrilling entertainment with the introspection that mentalism inspires. Rain or no rain, get ready to learn new, entertaining techniques that will add exciting dimensions to your magic.


