COME SIT A SPELL

Wizards Enjoy – And Perform – Summertime Sorcery

The magic of cooler temperatures prevailed for the Westside Wizards, who enjoyed their Summer Sorcery potluck amid mild July weather even as the rest of Los Angeles sweltered.

Held at **Dan and Jane Cray's** "Cottage of Conjuring," the annual event centered on good food and a great magic show—performed, of course, by several Assembly 291 members.

New member **Vincent Carden** warmed up the crowd with a captivating nautical rope routine, transforming the various ropes to identical length and then back, all of it perfectly themed to his job as a mate on a container ship.

The club was then treated to quantum entanglement lessons from **Brian Schwartz**, whose folded playing cards kept changing from red to blue backs. The science shifted to mystery as **Mel Agcaoili** linked and unlinked keychain rings in multiple, baffling ways.

Alex Scianna fried minds by having four volunteers each choose a playing card, then revealing that their selected cards matched predictions already sitting atop the performing table. Not to be outdone, **Howard Paris** used a prediction board to forecast audience members' school colors, a random number, and a selected playing card.

When **Dan Cray** launched into a card act, **Jane** locked him into a set of wooden stocks as "punishment" for violating a family rule that he never perform card tricks. Undaunted, Dan magically freed himself and was therefore granted permission to finish his routine... at which time he revealed that a volunteer's selected card matched a giant card that was held by an audience member the entire time.

Club founder **Les Cooper** was set to serve as the show's closer, but decided to "force" **Evan Cray** into performing a trick first. Evan, a former S.Y.M. member who recently performed in the Magic Castle's Close-up Gallery for Future Stars week, created a "clock face" from playing cards to predict a volunteer's randomly chosen hour... then revealed that the card at that hour's location matched the only card at the center of the clock.

Les then went forward with his set, which wrapped up with volunteer **Bill Bedecarre** somehow picking a queen from a hand of aces... meaning Les' prediction card—a stage-sized ace—was wrong! Only for a moment, though, as Les magically (and visually) transformed that ace into a queen, sending the Summer Sorcery crowd home on a sunny note. — *Dan Crav*


















President's Message

Congratulations Evan, and I look forward to seeing many more firsts from you.




