Wizards Show Off Their DIY Magic Skills At August Meeting

Summer is home improvement season, so the Westside Wizards decided to honor that with an unusual performing theme for their August meeting: hardware store magic! All routines were centered on home-made effects that rely on components found at a hardware or home supplies store.

The evening kicked off with a surprise visitor: founding member **Raul Fernandez**, who had a night away from his duties at the AMA's Magic University and came by to reconnect—and to show everyone how a hardware store washer strung on a rope has startling magical qualities.

Dan Cray used an empty, orange "Homer bucket" for something Home Depot executives never envisioned: a magic ritual. After adding water and dirt to the bucket, Dan had three members select a playing card from a blue-backed deck, then dumped a separate deck of red-backed cards into the muddy water. One by one, he found the sopping wet cards that matched the selected cards... and even when the third card had—surprise!—a photo of Lego bricks instead of a standard playing card image, Dan still produced a handful of Legos from the bucket.

Mel Agcaoili, Alex Scianna, Brian Schwartz, and Bill Dow all amazed using nuts, bolts, and cards, while Howard Paris impressed everyone with a set of 3-D-printed, engineering wonders that had to be seen to be believed. So, when the announcement is made at the September meeting, be the first to stand up and say "Count me in." You'll be glad you did. — Les Cooper




Open Mic Magic!


