IT'S SHOWTIME!

October is one of our favorite months of the year as spooky Halloween magic is in the air. Once again, the Westside Wizards will be performing a pair of magic shows for the public this Halloween season!

At our next in-person meeting at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, October 8, we will be doing a run-through of our shows and members can rehearse what they would like to perform at Shawn's Pumpkin Patch the following week.

The shows will be on Friday evening, October 18th, at Shawn's Pumpkin Patch. The address is 3443 South Sepulveda, near the corner of Sepulveda and Palms. (Note that the pumpkin patch has moved from the Santa Monica Blvd. location it was at the past two years.) **Please arrive at 6:45 pm.**—and bear in mind that Shawn's has no parking lot, so allow time to find street parking.

Our show times will be at 7:15 pm and 8:00 pm., for pumpkin shoppers who will be eager to see some magic, so please consider performing! Think large, visual magic with only brief presentations—these shows will each be approximately 15minutes and performed outdoors, for a standing, family audience that needs to see and hear the magic from considerable distances.

That means we need members to perform one or two short parlor or stage routines, for a total of no more than five minutes per member. Shawn's will supply a performing table, and there's a chance we'll have a backdrop, but assume you'll have limited control over audience viewing angles. There will also be a lot of background noise, since this will be a carnival-type atmosphere.

We'll be rehearsing at our regular October meeting (7 pm on Tuesday, Oct. 8th), so please bring the routine you'd like to perform and present it at the meeting so we can determine the number of performers and the length of each routine, and gather constructive comments from fellow club members.

Participation in the show is voluntary, but if you choose not to perform we welcome emceeing, audience management, or just having you come by to offer encouragement to fellow members.




